- + have a life and ministry consistent with Glenn Heasley's attributes and values,*
- + have served at least 6 years in Appalachian ministry,*
- + have been nominated*
- + have been recommended by at least 3 persons and their Bishop, and*
- + have been selected by the Award Review Committee.*

Award grants are expected to be \$1500. They may be used for Spiritual, Educational, or Family renewal projects.
